

The swim program was founded in memory of Fiona Stevenson, a British citizen who died tragically in the London bombing on July 7, 2005. Stevenson's love affair with swimming started from she was a child and when she came to Belize as a Challenge volunteer to

ork with the Ministry of Human development and Social Transformation, she gave some time the YWCA. Appalled that several Belizean children were drowning victims, she set out to iange that. When she died her family members founded the Fiona Stevenson Charity Fund in elize to provide annual swimming lessons and water safety courses, free of cost to children the ordinarily could not afford to pay for formal swimming lessons. This fund is serviced by indraising, donations and other charitable organizations and is administered by the YWCA. n organization whose names have become synonymous with summer programs for both adults ad children.
